Nationalism, Revolution and Reform Cereal Box

1750-1900 is filled with numerous revolutions and movements in reform, independence and unification. All are the results of the spreading of Enlightenment ideas. You will spotlight one of these movements to create a "cereal" that reflects the images, ideals, philosophies, causes, effects, and level of success of the movement you have been given.

The product will be a form of cereal that is cleverly named after your topic

EXAMPLE- "Mansa Musa's Golden Flakes", tagline- "Get a spoonful of Islamic generosity with every bite" *"Montesquieu's Chex and Balances", tagline- "A fair balance of flavor to prevent an upset stomach for society!"

Requirements for your cereal box.

How to construct your Cereal Box:

- Use an EMPTY cereal box from home (or a few google slides)
- Cover the outside of the box with construction paper or white paper
- Stuff the inside of the box with newspaper so it retains its shape.
- Use templates or your own design
- Images can be hand drawn or printed out. **BE CREATIVE**
- All work should be word-processed or **NEATLY** hand written

FRONT OF THE BOX (one slide)

- Name of the Product
- Tagline for the Product
- Picture of Person/Persons of importance in the movement AND a picture of the event
- One quote that is representative of your person/persons you are spotlighting.
- Design **MUST** by creative and eye-catching

BACK OF THE BOX (one slide)

- Image/Graphic/Picture that relates to the movement
- A map of the area where your movement has taken place (at the time of the movement)
- The time period (years) your movement took place. This is usually a span of time- most movements take more than one year.
- Important person/persons key philosophies and beliefs- What did they want to accomplish?
- MINIMUM of 3 causes of your movement- events/conditions that led to the rise of the movement
- MINIMUM of 3 effects of your movement- events/conditions that were a result of the movement

LEFT SIDE (one slide)

- 3 key interesting facts about the movement
- Other players and their role in the movement- even if they were not on the same side!
- 1 picture/image of your topic

RIGHT SIDE (one slide)

- Brief biography of your person associated with your movement
- 2 people who would get along with your person


